

# How to use a masonry BBQ

The product needs to be assembled. Grill secured a two-layer painting – primer, and then thick paint to preserve the original colour. Grill painted as pictured. Requires self – assembly. BBQ needs to be assembled with the use of high-temperature sealant- available in our store.

Small cracks and chips are considered normal while using Masonry BBQ, these are non-structural and won't affect the performance of the product. Please also be aware that it is normal for the cracks to expand when the product is in use and contract once it cools down. Indeed, you can simply fill it and paint over it with provided paint kit.

It is strongly advisable to locate this item on a hard surface, such as decking, concrete. If the barbecue is mounted directly on the ground it might collapse or cracks may form.

We advise starting using item by making a small fire and keeping it for some time, allowing it to slowly get used to temperature. The fuel must then be ignited slowly and gradually. This way the components have all the time to expand and eliminate the absorbed moisture without sudden changes. Not doing so may cause the BBQ to crack in places as per thermal shock.

BBQ in winter: Cracks may form on barbecues not covered with the cover, which is full of water and moisture. Indeed, the water may freeze and, by increasing its volume, it might create microcracks in the brickwork. Even if they are not visible, these small cracks will become much more visible when you fire up the barbecue for the first time, when the material will expand due to the heat. So it is important to always cover the barbecue in winter if it's not under the shelter.




# Pallet delivery info


- Bulky item - Kerb side delivery only on pallet

Pallet deliveries are made to a kerbside location.




Our driver will not be able to manoeuvre pallets up steep inclines.




In order to operate SAFE pump truck operations, we can only operate on solid, flat surfaces.




Our drivers are not permitted to enter your property.

# How to assemble a masonry BBQ

They are all delivered in separate sections on a pallet. These pre-built sections simply need stacking on top of each other with some adhesive to secure each piece firmly in place. To connect pieces, we suggest using flame -proof silicone that you can purchase in our store.

## Step 1

The first thing to do when taking delivery of your Masonry BBQ is to check over all pieces and ensure no damage has occurred in transit. Do this as soon as you receive the pallet from the driver, this is why there must be someone at home to receive the delivery in person.

## Step 2

The outdoor barbecue fireplace must be assembled on a compacted, level ground or concrete. Prepare the area where the foot of the BBQ will be.

## Step 3

Now it's time to build the masonry components of your BBQ, depending on the model you choose, the lower part or the "base" will be first. Assemble it without adhesive initially to check for level and ensure that you can see how it assembles together. Once satisfied use the silicone based adhesive or a refractory cement to firmly fix the components in to place.

## Step 4

You are now ready to assemble the firepit part of your BBQ.

## Step 5

Now you are ready to assemble the chimney securely on to the fire pit. It is best to ensure that all of the cement or adhesive is dry before doing this and you have people around to help because of the weight. It is best to take the chimney to the height of the BBQ and slide it on from front to back. The adhesive needs to be placed onto the top of the firepit walls rather than the base of the chimney. Make sure the chimney sits nice and square on top of the fireplace.

## Step 6

Insert any of the BBQ grills, rotisseries that are supplied and prepare to have your first BBQ
